**Update from Fr. Jon
on Our Rectory**

This year we have continued the discussion with the parish and finance councils about the repairs that are needed for the rectory, and what to do going forward. After careful thought and discussion the decision has been made to repair the rectory in stages.

The first stage will include the roof, windows, and brick.

A second stage will deal with the plumbing and electrical work and will be done at a later time.

We also will be looking to steadily repair the main church building. This will begin with replacing the north-facing doors of the church, and installation of a more secure card access system.

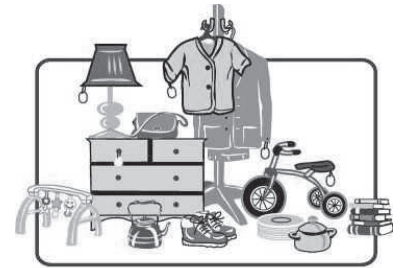
