New Security System

We will soon be replacing the two north-facing doors and the front doors (which are old and not closing properly). The new doors will be fitted with a card swipe access system in order to improve the overall security of our building.

The new system will be in place some time during the next week. The three main doors will be electronically programmed to open and close as follows:

Monday-Friday unlock at 8:30 am
lock at 6 pm

Saturday unlock at 8:30 am
lock at 10:30 am

Sunday unlock at 6:45 am
lock at 12:30 pm
unlock at 6 pm
lock at 10:30 pm

When there are evening or weekend meetings or events scheduled, the system will be programmed to open and lock the north-facing doors (the doors leading to the parking lot) accordingly. Therefore, it is important that these activities appear on our website calendar, or that you inform us in the parish office.



(The doors to the gym and social hall will not be impacted. If you have keys to those areas, they will continue to work.)
