**Commemoration of All the
Faithful Departed**



All Souls' Day is a day of prayer for all who have died. This is a particular way that we live out the command to love our neighbors, to pray for them, including those who have died. Many have had people close to them die. As a priest I have done funerals for family members—both my grandmother and my brother. Both of these were very different experiences, but powerful opportunities to encounter the Lord as we mourn the loss of a loved one, and hand the person over to Jesus in hope. This can be very painful. When we pray for them the church teaches us to pray in hope. When we are united with Jesus, even death cannot separate us from Him (as Saint Paul says in Romans 8). Death can lead us to reflect on how we live and how to best be prepared for that final moment of life. We don't want to guess the moment we will die, and try to get things in right order just before that time. Rather, we must live each day walking with the Lord, knowing it may be our last. This will also bring us deeper peace and freedom if we live this way. Let us pray for those who have died, and live in a way that invites Jesus to walk with us each day.

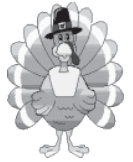
