# **Moving of the Tabernacle**

We are one family centered on Jesus present in the Eucharist. Today the tabernacle is in the sanctuary, under the big cross. The statues of Mary and Joseph have a new blue background behind them and kneelers in front, with the candles to the side. The presider's chair is now between the altar and tabernacle in a place close to where it has previously been. I want to remind people of the way we reverence the altar and the tabernacle. We reverence both because Jesus becomes present n the Eucharist on the altar, and he is present in the Eucharist in the tabernacle.

When mass is not going on, we genuflect to the tabernacle because Jesus is present there in the Eucharist. So if we walk into church, normally we would genuflect, going down on one knee. If someone is unable to genuflect for any reason, they can give a profound bow (which is a bow from the waist).

During mass we genuflect at the beginning when we come into mass, and at the end when we leave mass. Also, if someone opens the tabernacle, only that person genuflects. At all other times of mass the focal point is on the altar so at that time we give a bow to the altar from the waist (for example, the ushers going up for the collection or after someone brings the gifts up during mass, etc.).



Let us all ask the Lord Jesus to transform us more and more into His family through the Eucharist.
