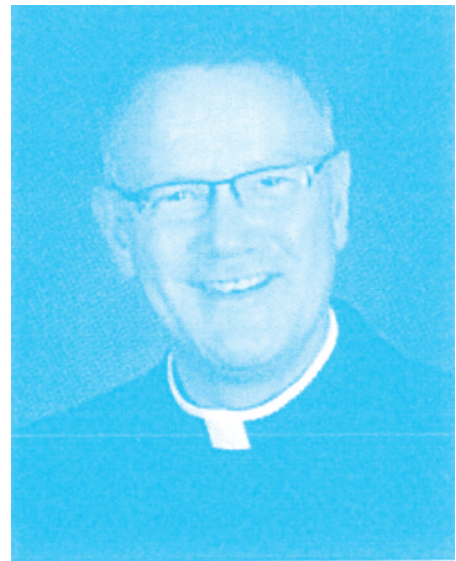

The Jesus Prayer is a form of unceasing prayer that is traced back to the early sixth century. This prayer is an invocation used by those practicing mental prayer, also called the “prayer of the heart.” The words of the prayer most usually said are “Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me a sinner.” The choice of this particular verse has a theological and spiritual meaning and repetition of the prayer leads to inner stillness.
