**St. Cyril of Jerusalem**

St. Cyril of Jerusalem was a 4<sup>th</sup> century bishop. As you may have guessed, he was the bishop in Jerusalem. He was remarkable for teaching the faith, teaching with incredible clarity about baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist. One of the unique things about those who went through his classes and came into the Church at the Easter Vigil is that the place where Jesus was crucified and the place of the resurrection were contained right in the church where St. Cyril celebrated mass and taught. During the class, therefore, he could bring them to the place of the crucifixion and resurrection. St. Cyril of Jerusalem said, "Our actions have a tongue of their own, even when the tongue is silent. For deeds prove our love more than words." Let us ask the Lord to help us grow in deeper relationship with Him as we come closer to Holy Week and Easter.

St. Cyril's feast day is March 18<sup>th</sup>.

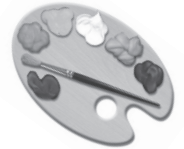
