**Saint John Climacus**

St. John Climacus was a monk in the early church. He was a hermit in Egypt on Mount Sinai, the same place where Moses received the Ten Commandments. He studied Scripture and the Fathers of the Church and gave wise counsel to many. He was known to help the distracted and those who were distressed. Once when a person accused him of talking too much, he remained silent for an entire year until the person who made the accusation begged him to continue giving wise counsel to others. One thing that he said was “in an instant many are pardoned for their mistakes, but no one, in a moment’s time, acquires calmness of the soul which requires much time, much trouble, and a great deal of help from God.”
