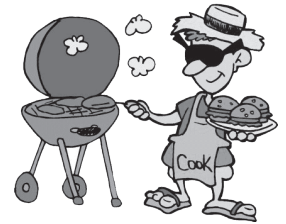
## Mother's Day Baby Bottle Fundraiser in Support of the University LifeCare Center
