Saint Julian of Norwich
(1342-1416)

St. Julian of Norwich was a mystic who had a deep life of prayer and deep insight. She said that "the greatest honor we can give to God is to live joyfully because of the knowledge of His love." In speaking about the deep gift of our lives, St. Julian said, "Our soul can never have rest in things that are beneath itself." There is a real truth in that, but how often do we find ourselves restless in pursuing things that won't truly satisfy. She also said "Peace and love are always alive in us, but we are not always alive to peace and love." Let us ask God -who is Love - to be more and more alive in us.

St. Julian lived during the terrible period of the Black Death, times of doom and gloom when half the population died agonizing deaths. In all of this, Julian offered a different perspective. Her witness was one of joy and compassion.



Today, as we celebrate mothers, let us remember St. Julian, for whom the bond between mother and child was the most profound way of understanding how God reaches out to His people.
