Saint Thomas More
1478-1535

St. Thomas More was a married man who was chancellor of England. He was asked to weigh in on an issue of the King's marriage that he did not agree with. He was never loudly lobbying and actually held his opinion to himself. However, he would not publicly approve when he felt he could not do so truthfully. St. Thomas More had a deep faith combined with a great sense of humor. He was full of wisdom and wit. He said "When we feel too bold let us remember our febleness and when we feel too faint, let us remember Christ's strength."



St. Thomas More was beheaded, and while he was being led to his death, he still had his sense of humor. He told the executioner who was leading him up the stairs to help him safely up, but that he would fend for himself on the way down.
