**Saint Anthony of Padua**

St. Anthony of Padua was a young Augustinian priest when he heard the stories of some Franciscans who died for their faith. He was inspired to do the same and sailed for Morocco. Poor health prevented him from being able to do this and he ended up in Italy, serving the Franciscans doing menial tasks. One day at the ordination of priests the person who was supposed to preach was not able to be there. They asked St. Anthony to preach, and were astounded by his knowledge and wisdom. He had the entire New Testament of the Bible memorized. His assignment then changed to preaching full time. St. Francis Assisi trusted St. Anthony, and eventually put him in charge of teaching the Franciscans about preaching. There is still a four-volume work of his homily outlines available. St. Anthony said, "consider every day of your life as a new beginning, the first day of your life." He also said, "Happy is the person whose words come from the Holy Spirit and not from himself." Let us ask the Lord to help us turn to Him anew each day.
