**Saint Bonaventure**

(1221-1274)

St. Bonaventure was one of the early Franciscans. He is often called the second founder of the Franciscans because he led them through a very difficult time. St. Bonaventure was an incredible scholar. He taught at the University of Paris where St. Thomas Aquinas also taught. As well as being co-workers, they were friends.



St. Thomas once asked St. Bonaventure “where did you get such wisdom?” St. Bonaventure simply pointed at the crucifix and indicated it came through contemplating Jesus’ life, death and resurrection. He left his teaching position to take up leadership, for many years, of the Franciscans. He was eventually made a Cardinal. When the messenger came with the announcement and the red hat of a Cardinal, he found Bonaventure washing dishes. He told the messenger to hang the red hat on a tree until he was finished with the dishes.

Saint Bonaventure’s Feast Day is July 15<sup>th</sup>.
