Saint Ignatius of Loyola
(1491-1556 AD)



St. Ignatius of Loyola is a great saint of the Church. He grew up in modern-day Spain and was a very gifted soldier. When his legs were crushed by a canon ball, his town fell to the enemy. The enemy they were fighting had such respect for him that they took him with them to nurse him back to good health. He was not a moral man in his younger days, but as he was recovering from his battle wounds, he began to read about St. Francis and St. Dominic. He wondered, “What if I became like them?” He founded the Society of Jesus, also known as the Jesuits. He wanted every member to encounter Jesus Christ in a very real way and developed the thirty-day retreat that every member of the Jesuits would have to go through. At a certain point he was imprisoned for some of his teaching, but he did not lose his wit. St. Ignatius of Loyola simply said, “I didn’t know that it was a new idea to teach Christians about Christ.” Let us ask the Lord to help us love and serve Him and our neighbors in everything that we do.

St. Ignatius of Loyola’s Feast day is July 31.

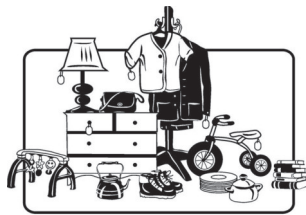
The book for July is The Giver, by Lois Lowry. All women of the parish are cordially invited!
