Saint Faustina

The Lord appeared to St. Faustina, a religious sister in Poland, and gave her an image and many messages of His Divine Mercy. She recorded them in her diary.

The Lord said to her:

“I am Love and Mercy itself. When a soul approaches Me with trust, I fill it with such an abundance of graces that it cannot contain them within itself, but radiates them to other souls.”

“There is no misery that could be a match for My mercy, neither will misery exhaust it, because as it is being granted, it increases. The soul that trusts in My mercy is most fortunate, because I myself take care of it.”

On the rosary there is a chaplet of divine mercy; it is a tremendous way to pray. St. Faustina is a very appropriate saint for this time when Pope Francis calls us to the truth of God’s Mercy.
