Saint Joseph of Cupertino

(June 17, 1603—September 18, 1663)

St. Joseph of Cupertino is someone who definitely had supplied by God what he lacked. He was known to be absentminded—so much so that for the early part of his life he answered almost every question with, “I forgot.” He wanted to be a Franciscan, but was not able to join because of his inability to carry out very simple tasks. He barely made it through his studies.

Then the Lord gave him a deep gift of spiritual discernment. People would seek him out for all kinds of advice. He often stopped assassination attempts from knowledge he would spiritually receive, even one time saving a king from being poisoned. He is a saint who is a reminder that God can do great things even in the midst of our limitations. Let us pray that the Lord does all He wants in us and through us.
