Saint Therese of Lisieux
(1873-1897)

St. Therese is popularly known as “**The Little Flower of Jesus**” or simply, “**The Little Flower.**” She is a saint who is remarkable for how hidden and yet exposed her life is. She grew up in France and joined the Carmelites and lived in their convent. She died at the young age of 24, and yet she is called the greatest saint of modern times. Therese has been a highly influential model of sanctity for Catholics and for others because of the simplicity and practicality of her approach to the spiritual life. She said that she could not do any great things, but rather small things with great love. She has a very popular novena (a prayer that is said nine days in a row).
