**(1515-1582)**

St. Teresa of Avila is one of the great saints in the history of the Church. She was called to a very deep relationship with Jesus. She actually turned away from this invitation at first because she could not understand how God was doing these deep things in her while she was a sinner. She eventually saw that as a great mistake and said, "the Lord is never content to give us as little as we desire."

St. Teresa was a whirlwind who was at the center of reforming the Carmelites. She recruited St. John of the Cross and because he was short, she called him half of a priest. She had a tremendous sense of humor and deep love. She said, "I have no defense against affection, I could be bribed with a sardine." She was a person of great joy and would say, "From sullen saints, save us O Lord, Lord hear our prayer."

Let us ask the Lord to help us to respond to the Lord's invitation and follow him with great love and joy.
