Saint Catherine Laboure
(1806-1876)



St. Catherine became a religious sister at the age of 24. She was a member of the Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul, and a Marian visionary who relayed the request from the Blessed Virgin Mary to create the Miraculous Medal. This is a medal of Mary that was known as the medal of the Immaculate Conception, worn by millions of Christians, both Roman

Catholic and non-denominational. It was known as the miraculous medal because so many miracles happened very soon after it was made. Nobody (except her spiritual director) knew that St. Catherine was the one who received the vision. She was silent about it for 50 years.



St. Catherine Laboure is a model of humility and faithfulness to God. Let us ask the Lord to help us to be faithful to what He calls us to in love and humility.
