Saint Andrew of Avellino
(c. 1521-1608)

St. Andrew of Avellino was an Italian saint. Born at Castronuovo, a small town in Sicily, his baptismal name was Lancelotto. Because of his love for the cross, he changed his name to Andrew when he entered the Order of Theatines.



When asked for advice from a priest, his response was both wise and humorous. The priest asked, "How long should one remain at the bedside of a sick person?" St. Andrew replied, "Always be brief. There are two advantages: if they like you, they will be happy to see you come back. If you are boring, their displeasure will be short."

Let us ask the Lord to give us wisdom and joy as St. Andrew lived.
