The sacrament of Baptism gives us the life of God within us. We enter into a special relationship with God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit through baptism. When a child is baptized there is a strong prayer spoken at the beginning. The priest says, "I claim you for Christ our savior by the sign of His cross." Then the priest and the parents and Godparents make the sign of the cross on the child's forehead. When we live our baptismal call as Christians, it is important to renew the reality that "I belong to Jesus Christ and I renounce other claims on my life that may compete with that." To renew our baptism is to reject sin and to turn to God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Let us ask the Lord to help us respond fully to His love in our lives.
