Saint Anthony of the Desert

St. Anthony of the Desert, a Christian monk from Egypt, lived in the early Church. He heard the Lord call him to leave everything and follow Him. He did just that. He went out in the desert and became one of the early Desert Fathers. He influenced people in all walks of life. Greek philosophers would make the long journey to seek him out for his wisdom. People who felt called to live the same way of life he did sought him out. Also, other saints who did not live in the desert like Anthony, were moved by his witness. St. Athanasius was a friend of his, and St. Augustine was so moved when he heard about St. Anthony of the Desert that it was a major part of his conversion.

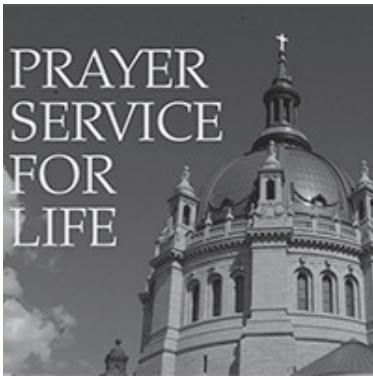

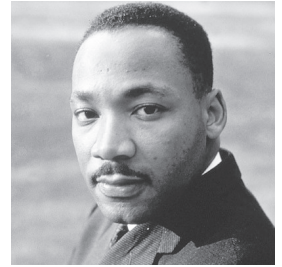
