**Saint Cyril of Jerusalem**  
(c. 313-386 AD)

St. Cyril of Jerusalem is a Father of the Church. This means he was one of the early important teachers of the faith. He is also a Doctor of the Church, one of only about thirty. Their teaching has important significance.

St. Cyril taught about the mysteries of the faith in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. This church has in it the place where Jesus was both crucified and died, and the tomb where he was buried and rose from the dead. As St. Cyril would teach the mysteries of the faith, he would instruct those entering into the Church about the incredible gift of Jesus' love that comes to us in the sacraments.



Let us ask the Lord as we approach Holy Week to help us to encounter Him more fully in our lives.

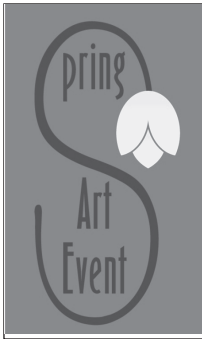
