Saint Catherine of Siena

(c. 1347-1380)

St. Catherine of Siena was a remarkable woman who was called to a life of prayer in the midst of family life and the world. She was an advisor to the pope, and served the poor and sick in remarkable ways. She had gifts of healing, and even raised the dead. She came to a deep relationship with the Lord by praying in her own home. She corrected someone who felt he would lose his faith if he left the countryside. She said, "Your faith must not be very solid if you lose it in changing places. It would seem that God only stays in the forest and not in places where he is most needed." St. Catherine gave this advice, "Build yourself a cell in your heart and go there to pray."

Her Feast Day is April 29th.

Parish Lawsuit

A lawsuit has been started against St. Lawrence. While it has not yet been filed with the court, a summons has been issued and there is additional information we can share at this time.

St. Lawrence and the Paulist Fathers are defendants in a complaint.

The claim involves an incident that occurred in the mid 60s between the plaintiff and Fr. Anthony Wilhelm, CSP, and alleges negligence-based claims relating to supervision of Fr. Wilhelm.

This is one of the claims against the archdiocese, and the hope is that it will be settled as part of the overall bankruptcy settlement.

We ask that you pray for all victims of abuse and for a just resolution of any lawsuit that may be filed against the parish.
