Saint Joan of Arc

(January 6, 1412 — May 30, 1431)

St. Joan of Arc was an incredible saint. She was a mystic and had many experiences in prayer. She was also a soldier and led the armies of France. She did not like swearing, and when she was angry would say, “by my martin” instead of anything else. St. Joan of Arc is the patron of France. She died at the young age of 19, which is incredible considering the role that she played in society. Mark Twain, who is one of the greatest writers in U.S. history, and not a person of deep faith, was so fascinated by her that he spent twelve years researching her life. He wrote the book, Joan of Arc, that is well worth reading. Even though he wrote classics in fiction literature like Huckleberry Finn, he considered Joan of Arc his most important book.
