## *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*

### **Archbishop Hebda**

On Friday, May 13th the Cathedral (which holds 3,000 people) was packed for the installation of Archbishop Hebda. It was a beautiful celebration with lots of people from the Archdiocese and many from around the country. Many bishops were present along with several hundred priests and religious, and a very large number of the lay faithful present. During the installation Mass the Papal Nuncio, who is Pope Francis' representative to the United States, read the declaration of the appointment of Archbishop Hebda to be the ninth Archbishop of St. Paul and Minneapolis.

It was a time of great joy and hope for the Archdiocese. You could see clearly Archbishop Hebda's humility, his humor, and his focus on Jesus Christ. He shared that he is weak. He joked about how short he is, saying that when he sits comfortably in the cathedra (the bishop's chair) his feet don't touch the ground. Also at the end of the Mass he thanked Pope Francis for appointing him as Archbishop, and then announced to those in attendance that Pope Francis wasn't able to be there that day.

During his homily he focused on Jesus. He said that even if we are stripped of everything, the only thing we need is Jesus Christ. There is a profound truth in what the Archbishop is pointing us to. If it seems we have everything, but we do not have Jesus Christ, we have nothing. If it seems like we have nothing but Jesus, we have everything.



Let us pray for Archbishop Hebda and for all of us, that we can respond and share the saving love of Christ that has been given to the Church.
