Saint Romuald

St. Romuald lived 1,000 years ago. He was a man who had a deep yearning for the love of God. St. Peter Damian, who Dante (in *The Divine Comedy*), identified as the highest saint, looked to St. Romuald as an example of following Jesus with your whole heart, soul, mind and strength. He is the founder of the Camaldolese Hermits, and yet he was asked to go and preach and reform different situations in the Church. One of the things that he taught was to pray paying careful attention to each word. He had a mentality that it was better to pray one psalm with attention than to pray all 150 without attention. Let us ask that we can follow the Lord with everything we have, and be witnesses to others as St. Romuald was.
