**Saint Anthony of Padua**

(c. 1195-1231)

Saint Anthony of Padua was a Franciscan in the very early days of the order. He knew Saint Francis personally and St. Francis asked him to do the teaching of the Franciscan Friars. He served in manual labor in a hidden way while with the Franciscans. He then went to an ordination of priests with the Franciscans and Dominicans, and there was a mix-up as to who was supposed to give the homily. Finally they asked Anthony to do it. He did an incredible job, and for the rest of his life he was a preacher full-time. St. Anthony had the entire new testament of the Bible memorized. Many miracles are attributed to him. Let us ask the Lord that we might serve Him and His people in humble and hidden ways, or in any way the Lord desires of us.
