Saint Vincent Ferrer and Humility

St. Vincent (1350-1419) was a Spanish Dominican priest. He spoke about humility. He said, "Whoever proudly disputes and contradicts will always stand outside the door. Christ, the master of humility, reveals his truth to the humble and hides himself from the proud." The truth is that humility draws God closer to us and pride makes Him more distant. We can see this all through Scripture, beginning with the book of Genesis with the Tower of Babel. Its clearest example is in Jesus, who humbles himself to come and save us out of love. St. Paul's letter to the Philippians, Chapter 2, speaks of this beautifully:

"Have among yourselves the same attitude that is also yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus, every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."



Let us ask the Lord that we might grow in the love and humility of Jesus.

Missionary Appeal Next Sunday

The Diocese of Mamfe in Cameroon is a young diocese created in 1999 by St. John Paul II. Located in the south-west region of Cameroon and bordering the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the Diocese is engaged in primary evangelization, reaching out to many Africans who have never heard the name Jesus Christ. Thus far the diocese has 32 parishes and 65 priests. They have created new primary schools for the children who otherwise would have no access to education. With little or no access to health care, the diocese is trying to provide basic clinics for patients to fight malaria, typhoid, and other tropic diseases, including the provision of health care to HIV AIDS patients, and post-natal care for mothers to reduce the mortality rate. With so much farmland, the diocese is trying to open farms to help towards the self-sustenance of the diocese. There is also urgent need to form lay leaders as well as priests, seminarians and religious men and women for the mission of evangelization.

These issues and many others provide a dire need for external support for the work of the Diocese of Mamfe, given that many in the diocese are poor and live on less than a dollar a day.
