**Saint Bonaventure**

(1221-1271)

St. Bonaventure was a Franciscan saint. He is often referred to as the second founder. After Sts. Francis and Anthony of Padua had died, the order moved into a difficult period. St. Bonaventure had been teaching at the University of Paris—he was one of the great thinkers in the history of the Catholic Church. He was the subject of Pope Benedict XVI's doctoral thesis. He was friends with St. Thomas Aquinas, who also taught at the University of Paris. St. Thomas at times would ask St. Bonaventure where he got his insights. St. Bonaventure would simply point to Jesus on the cross. He said, "in our prayers what must be heard is not what comes out of our mouths, but what comes from our hearts."

Let us ask the Lord to transform our hearts to seek Him in all things.
