Saint John Cassian
(c. 360-435 AD)

St. John Cassian is a saint who lived in the fourth century. He went to Palestine to live with monks, and then moved to live with the desert fathers in Egypt. He became one of them for a number of years.

When St. John Cassian returned to Europe, a couple of bishops asked him to write about the monastic life. He wrote the *Institutes* and then the *Conferences*. These reflect the lessons he learned from the desert fathers in Egypt. His teaching led to a powerful influence of the monastic life in western culture.

St. Benedict, the founder of the Benedictines, uses St. John Cassian as one of his main sources, along with St. Basil in the Rule of St. Benedict.

St. John Cassian had an understanding that the Lord can heal us when we pray deeply. He said, "The Doctor of our souls has placed the remedy in the hidden regions of the soul."

Let us ask the Lord to help us live every moment in His love.
