**Saint
Augustine**

(c. 354—430)



St. Augustine, the son of St. Monica, was an incredible saint. He was an amazing writer (among his most important works are *The City of God* and *Confessions*). He was also a bishop and a man of deep prayer, understanding that prayer was not a way for him to get what he wanted from God. His philosophy was that “no one is truly happy if he has what he wants, but only if he wants something he should have.” Happiness is not found in getting everything we want. Some of our desires may need to be purified and to change. It is encountering God and the situations that He allows in life—with love of God and neighbor—that this change can happen. Then, instead of our desires leading us everywhere so that we are enslaved to them, our desires can be ordered and healed to become what they are meant to be by the Lord. Let us ask the Lord not simply to give us what we want at the moment. Let us ask Him instead to teach us, form us, and heal us to desire what we should desire in Him.
