**Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross**

**Born in 1891 in Wroclaw, Poland**  
**Died in 1942 in Auschwitz concentration camp,**  
**Oswiecim, Poland**

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross was a brilliant philosopher who studied realist-phenomenology. Other well-known realist-phenomenologists are Detrich Von Hildebrand and St. John Paul II. Her birth name is Edith Stein. She grew away from her faith, but upon reading of St. Teresa of Avila, she became Catholic and eventually became a religious sister. She joined St. Teresa's community, the Carmelites.



St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross wrote many works on philosophy and the spiritual life. During World War II she was arrested and taken to a concentration camp. While there she cared for the children whose mothers had lost hope and could no longer care for their children. She is a wonderful example of someone who heroically loves God and neighbor.

There is a great book on her life while in the concentration camp entitled Edith Stein and Companions, by Fr. Paul Hamans.
