Saint Scholastica

St. Scholastica was a fraternal twin to St. Benedict, the founder of the Benedictine order. The two twins were in monasteries about five miles apart. St. Gregory the Great wrote that the last time they were able to visit, they were sharing about the faith with each other at St. Scholastica's convent. St. Benedict knew he should leave to get back to his monastery, but St. Scholastica wanted him to stay. But he refused. Then she bowed her head and prayed. An incredible rain storm began. St. Benedict said, "sister what did you do?" She said, "I asked you if you would stay and you said no, so I asked God." In the midst of things in our lives do we turn to the Lord with them? Do we turn only when we want something? Do we turn in thanksgiving about big things? Do we pray about small things? Let us ask the Lord to give us the grace to turn toward Him in prayer throughout the day in all the circumstances of our lives.
