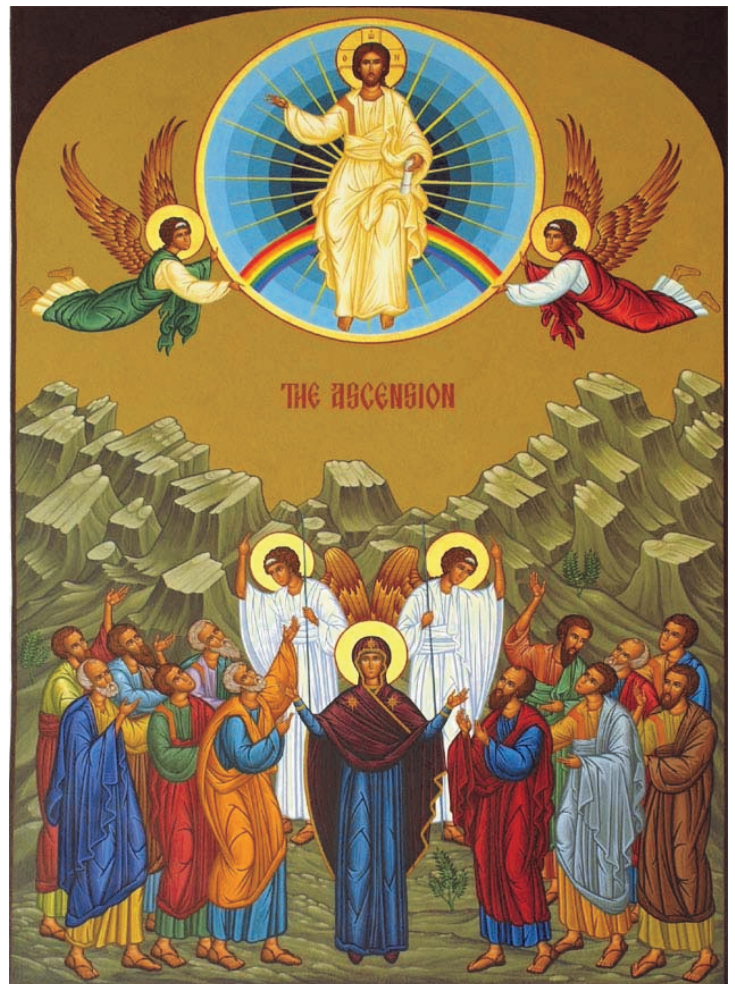
New Members
