Presbyteral Assembly

In June the priests of the Archdiocese gathered with Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens for our bi-annual presbyteral assembly. There were more than 250 priests present. It is a time to come together to pray and be formed, and to listen to a variety of speakers.

Bishop Paul Sirba from the diocese of Duluth joined us for one of the days. He was originally a priest of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, so it was good to have him back with us. Bishop Sirba shared about walking with Jesus. One thing that struck me that he reflected on was being joyful in the midst of suffering and misunderstanding. This obviously is not our natural response, but can come when we are united with Jesus in the midst of those trials. Pope Francis has consistently called for such a response. Let us ask the Lord to be with us in the midst of those trials we face in life and those situations we suffer in, and ask for that gift of Joy and Peace in the midst of those trials by being united with Jesus even then.
