Remembering Deacon Paul

Have you ever looked at the pamphlets in the Gathering Space that were written by Deacon Paul Carlson, and perhaps wondered who he was?



Deacon Paul Carlson was ordained to the diaconate in 1976, part of the first class of deacons. He served as a catechist at the Paulist Information Center for over 45 years. He taught Scripture in 132 parishes throughout the archdiocese, and he taught Scripture for 22 years in the diaconate formation program. Deacon Carlson was a member of the Marriage Tribunal for 29 years, serving as a judge for 25 of those years.

The RCIA classes taught by Deacon Paul were very large. Just a couple of examples are that in 1982 sixty-five people were brought into the church; in 1983 on Christmas Eve 30 people were confirmed (Profession of Faith).

Deacon Paul died April 20, 2011.
