St. Anthony of Padua

St. Anthony of Padua's feast day was recently celebrated (June 13). He is a very popular and amazing saint. St. Anthony joined the Franciscans as a priest after he saw some of the early Franciscans go to Morocco and become martyrs. He wanted to follow and, like them, become a martyr. His health prevented him from doing that. Instead he spent a year with the Franciscans in a very hidden way doing lots of cleaning. Then at an ordination with the Franciscans and Dominicans, there was much confusion and nobody was prepared to give the homily. St. Anthony did it without any preparation and astounded them with his gifts of preaching.



A concordance is a book that highlights where you can find certain words in the Bible. For example, the word "light." The concordance will tell you all the places you can find that word in the Scripture. St. Anthony was known as the concordance because of his knowledge of Scripture. He had the entire New Testament of the Bible memorized. St. Anthony is known best for finding lost objects, but he is also a doctor of the Church and brought the light of Christ to all who encountered him.
