**Saint John Vianney**

St. John Vianney was a parish priest in France. He died in 1859. He had struggles with schooling, and was not very respected. He was placed in Ars, a very small town. He said Mass, cared for orphans, and is not known for hearing confessions. He heard confessions for up to 16 hours a day (you could say he lived in the confessional!).

One might think that St. John Vianney had much time to read in the confessional, but an extraordinary thing happened. So many people flocked out to this little out-of-the-way town that they built train tracks with a stop out there just for people going to see him for confession. The line to go to him wrapped around the church, and it was normally a two- to three-day wait.

St. John Vianney offered the love and mercy of God that people were starving for. Let us pray for this gift to receive God's mercy and share that gift with others.

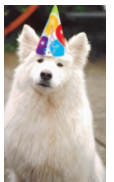
