Saint Bernard of Clairvaux

St. Bernard of Clairvaux was a person who had a very strong and infectious personality. He is a doctor of the Church, and wrote works on the Song of Songs, and also wrote beautifully about Mary and many other things.

When he decided to go to the monastery, many of his family and friends tried to talk him out of it. They were not able to. In fact, he was so convincing in his conviction that 35 others join with him at the same time.

It is said that he was so charismatic that mothers would hide their sons when he came to town. They worried about losing them to the monastery, which would probably mean they would not see them again.

St. Bernard is a good example of how the Lord builds on our natural gifts and our personalities. We may be asked to take steps in faith that stretch us, but living the faith does not mean rejecting who we are. It is in fact, becoming more fully who we are in Christ.

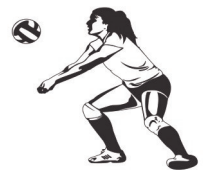
Women's Book Club
