Saint Hildegarde



We are in a phase in life that is very conscious about health in areas of exercise and food. St. Hildegarde, who died in 1179, created a food regimen which she, along with many others, believed would lead to both physical and spiritual joy. One of her remedies we might find humorous. She said, “For those who are quick-tempered and who get upset easily and often, warm some wine and add some cold water to it and drink it down in sufficient quantities until their mood changes. Repeat as needed. The result will be a reduction in their bad moods.”

There is a truth sometimes when things are stressful and overwhelming that rest, eating healthy foods and exercise can help improve things on some level. This is cooperating with the way the Lord made us. We can obviously get obsessed and have our focus on those things lose balance, but they are important and often a first step to look at in addressing an issue. Let us ask the Lord to give us gratitude for the way that He has made us, and cooperate with the way we are created.

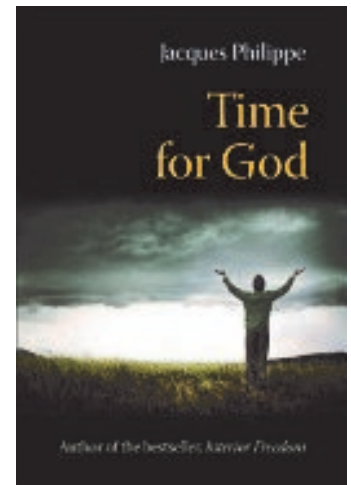
Parish Reading Project
