Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Saint Margaret of Clitherow

St. Margaret of Clitherow was the daughter of a candle maker in the 16th century. She lived in a time when Catholics were greatly persecuted. She was married and had children. She exuded deep faith and was punished for it.

St. Margaret was imprisoned for two years for being Catholic. She was put in a cold, dirty cell, and given very poor food. Yet she was united with the Lord in these trials, and described that time as happy and profitable.

She hid persecuted priests in a special room that was built in her house. Her children and husband remained silent about this, even under interrogation. Eventually someone outside of her family shared this and she was convicted and sentenced to be pressed to death. That does not sound very pleasant. She went to death smiling and sent her hat to her husband as a sign of her love for him, and her shoes to one of her daughters as a sign to walk in her footsteps.



St. Margaret was joyful and witty. Everyone loved her and would run to her for help, comfort and counsel. Let us ask the Lord to help us remain united with Him in the midst of all trials and ask St. Margaret to help us choose to be united with the Lord in all circumstances so we can love God and our neighbor with peace and joy.
