**Sacraments**

The Catholic Church has seven sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist are sacraments of initiation. Baptism is the doorway to all the sacraments, and all things in the sacramental life flow from and lead to the Eucharist.

There are also sacraments that help us when we are wounded: Reconciliation and Anointing. Reconciliation repairs our relationship with God, the Church, and our neighbors, and our relationship with our self because sin divides us against ourselves. Anointing helps draw the Lord into a situation of health that we are suffering, and that can often leave us feeling alone and isolated. It brings God's peace and an encounter with Him in the midst of our suffering.

Finally, there are two vocational sacraments: Marriage and Holy Orders. These sacraments are two specific sacramental ways we live our love of God and our neighbor. The focus of both is the holiness of others.

Let us ask the Lord to help us be strengthened in the life of grace and our relationship with Him in the Church through the sacraments.
