## Tenebrae Service

**Tuesday, March 27, 7:30 pm**  
**in the Gathering Space**



The Tenebrae Service is an ancient Liturgy of the Word that symbolically moves from light to darkness. This service is often celebrated on Tuesday or Wednesday of Holy Week, and is meant to contrast the Easter Vigil that moves from darkness to light. The movement toward increasing darkness is meant to cause a spiritual and physical recognition that during these days 2000 years ago man rejected and betrayed their savior. This darkness is not a simple memory from the past, but a current reminder that still to this very day we continue to reject and betray our savior in our present sins. We will join Catholics all over the world who will participate in this same spiritual experience of sober recognition that "the light came into the world but men preferred darkness."

We would especially like to extend a welcome to all our parishioners to join the students this Tuesday evening.
