Saint Giles of Assisi

c. 1190-1262

St. Giles was one of the first followers of St. Francis of Assisi. He was an early Franciscan. Although he had no formal education, he was sought for his wisdom because of the holiness of his life. He encouraged prayer and love of neighbor. He said, "Blessed is he who does good to others and desires not that others should do good to him." His advice on getting along with others was quite simple: "If you love, you will be loved and if you serve, you will be served." This humble saint is a reminder to us that holiness does not lie with being humanly impressive, but with being totally given to love of God and neighbor. Let us ask the Lord to allow the love of the risen Christ Jesus to transform our lives to live out this love.
