***Independence Day***

On the Fourth of July we celebrate the freedom we have as a country, and we honor those who have given their lives as a gift of that freedom. Recently I was reading about the life of St. John Vianney, who was a simple and holy priest in France. He was ordained in 1815. His formal religious training was clouded by the times he lived in. He was a child during the French Revolution and had to sneak to designated houses for Mass in the middle of the night. The priest and the people who attended risked their lives to pray. In these circumstances he received his first confession and communion. This marked him for the rest of his life.

St. John Vianney sacrificed his life so heroically because he grew up seeing others risk their lives to practice the faith.
