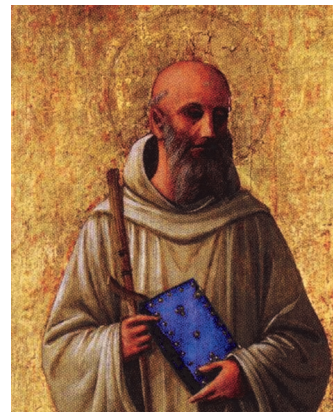

c. 951-1025

Sometimes the painful situations in life can be used in a fruitful way. St. Romuald was traumatized as a young man when he saw his father kill a relative in a duel over property. Romuald fled and entered the monastery. He lived an incredibly holy life. In *The Divine Comedy* St. Peter Damian is considered to be the greatest saint, and the saint he most admired was St. Romuald. He always pondered about how St. Romuald would handle this situation.

St. Romuald was the founder of the Camaldolese Hermits. He was a person whose holiness both attracted others and convicted others. He was made head of a monastery and then later was beaten and chased out. He always sought the Lord and was known for his incredible prayers and zeal in being a witness to Christ in all circumstances.



No matter what circumstances we find ourselves in, let us never give up hope because the Lord can enter even the most painful situations and transform us to bear beautiful fruit for Him.
