Saint Bonaventure
(c. 1221-1274)

St. Bonaventure was an early member of the Franciscan community. He was a brilliant professor alongside St. Thomas Aquinas at the University of Paris. They had great admiration and respect for one another. St. Thomas asked St. Bonaventure, “how do you have such insight?” Saint Bonaventure simply pointed to Jesus on the cross.



St. Bonaventure said “spiritual joy and happiness are the surest sign of God’s grace in the soul.” He also spoke about how we find happiness explaining that true happiness can only be found in the highest good, which is God. As a result he understood that we cannot be truly happy unless we go beyond ourselves in receiving and responding to the Love of God.

St. Bonaventure had an image of wounded humanity being hunched over due to sin, and God over time through grace transformed us to stand upright. Let us ask the Lord to help us grow beyond ourselves and be transformed by receiving and responding to the gift of His Love.
