Scholastica**



The Monastic Life is full of many great saints, an example being the Desert Fathers. The first Desert Father was St. Paul Thebes, and the most famous is St. Antony of the Desert. St. John Cassian was a Desert Father who came from Egypt to Europe, bringing all that he had learned with him. He shared this wisdom in The Conferences and The Institutes. St. Basil wrote one of the 1st Monastic Rules. Other monks such as St. Anselm and St. Bernard had incredible impacts as well. St. Benedict is a great giant in the middle of them. He was influenced by St. John Cassian and the Desert Fathers along with St. Basil.

St. Scholastica was a fraternal twin to St. Benedict, the founder of the Benedictine order. They lived in monasteries about five miles from each other. St. Gregory the Great shared that on the last time they were able to visit, they shared about the faith with each other at St. Scholastica's convent. St. Benedict knew he should return to his monastery. St. Scholastica wanted him to stay, but he refused. Then she bowed her head and prayed. An incredible rain storm began. St. Benedict said, "Sister, what did you do?" She said, "I asked you if you would stay and you said no, so I asked God." Let us ask the Lord to help us receive from others the gift of faith, hope and love, and to share it with others as the Lord opens these doors.
