The Passionist Fathers



A number of saints came from the religious order, the Passionists. Their founder was St. Paul of the Cross. Other saints from this order include Dominic Barbareri (who helped John Henry Newman become Catholic), Maria Goretti and Gemma Galgami. St. Gabriel Possenti was a Passionist priest who lived in the nineteenth century. He preached regularly, by referring to his own life, to avoid the near occasion of sin. The areas that he taught to be careful in the near occasion of sin are things we could apply to our own day. St. Gabriel told people to be careful about the places they go, what they read, and the abandoned pursuit of pleasure.

What am I feeding my senses through sight, hearing, etc.? This becomes a greater challenge in our age of technology where we are bombarded with all kinds of things all the time. Let us ask the Lord during the upcoming season of Lent that we recognize Him as our true peace.
