Saint Catherine of Siena



St. Catherine of Siena was a remarkable woman who was called to a life of prayer in the midst of family life and the world. She was an advisor to popes, received a revelation from God the Father that she wrote in her Dialogue, and she served the poor and sick in remarkable ways. She had gifts of healing and even raised the dead. All this happened in her life even though she died in her early 30s. She came to this deep relationship with the Lord by praying in her own home. She once corrected someone who felt he would lose his faith if he left the countryside. She said, “Your faith must not be very solid if you lose it in changing places. It would seem that God only stays in the forest and not in places where he is most needed.”

St. Catherine of Siena gave this advice: “Build yourself a cell in your heart and go there to pray.”
